1. State-funded mainstream schools include academies, free schools, city technology colleges and further education colleges with provision for 14- to 16-year-olds. They exclude state-funded special schools, independent schools, independent special schools, non-maintained special schools, hospital schools, pupil referral units and alternative provision. Alternative provision includes academy and free school alternative provision.

2. A full explanation of how expected progress is calculated is included in the SFR methodology document.

3. Around 25% of maintained schools boycotted key stage 2 tests in 2010. Where pupils have missing test results due to the 2010 boycott, teacher assessments have been used as their prior attainment level.

4. In 2010, single level tests in mathematics were piloted in a number of primary schools. Prior attainment in mathematics includes single level tests of pupils who attended these schools.

5. Local authority, region and the total (state-funded mainstream sector) figures cover achievements in state-funded mainstream schools only. They do not include pupils recently arrived from overseas and so will not match with state-funded mainstream figures in the main tables and the 'England' line above which include all pupils.

6. Figures for 2014/2015 are revised, all other years are final.

7. In 2014/15, early entry policy, under which only a pupil's first attempt at a qualification is counted in performance measures, is extended to all subjects (see SFR main text).

8. In 2013/14, two major reforms were implemented which affect the calculation of key stage 4 performance measures data: 1) Professor Alison Wolf's Review of Vocational Education recommendations which: restrict the qualifications counted; prevent any qualification from counting as larger than one GCSE; and cap the number of non-GCSEs included in performance measures at two per pupil, and 2) an early entry policy to only count a pupil's first attempt at a qualification, in subjects counted in the English Baccalaureate.
