- State-funded mainstream schools include academies, free schools, city technology colleges and further education colleges with provision for 14- to 16-year-olds. They exclude state-funded special schools, independent schools, independent special schools, non-maintained special schools, hospital schools, pupil referral units and alternative provision. Alternative provision includes academy and free school alternative provision.
- A full explanation of how expected progress is calculated is included in the SFR methodology document.
- Around 25% of maintained schools boycotted key stage 2 tests in 2010. Where pupils have missing test results due to the 2010 boycott, teacher assessments have been used as their prior attainment level.
- In 2010, single level tests in mathematics were piloted in a number of primary schools. Prior attainment in mathematics includes single level tests of pupils who attended these schools.
- Local authority, region and the total (state-funded mainstream sector) figures cover achievements in state-funded mainstream schools only. They do not include pupils recently arrived from overseas and so will not match with state-funded mainstream figures in the main tables and the 'England' line above which include all pupils.
- Figures for 2014/2015 are revised, all other years are final.
- In 2014/15, early entry policy, under which only a pupil's first attempt at a qualification is counted in performance measures, is extended to all subjects (see SFR main text).
- In 2013/14, two major reforms were implemented which affect the calculation of key stage 4 performance measures data: 1) Professor Alison Wolf's Review of Vocational Education recommendations which: restrict the qualifications counted; prevent any qualification from counting as larger than one GCSE; and cap the number of non-GCSEs included in performance measures at two per pupil, and 2) an early entry policy to only count a pupil's first attempt at a qualification, in subjects counted in the English Baccalaureate.
